## 9) Rules

(a) Based on the competition rules of the China Karate Association's Full-Contact Karate Committee, with adopting the principle of implementing certain requirements in accordance with the specific procedures of the regulations.

(b) This competition adopts the "five-person system" referee group and a simple majority decision method. Any "score" or "foul" on the playing field requires the support of more than three referees before the judgement is made. All referees on the court have only one vote (the chief judge has no priority).

(c) Each individual fighter is disqualified from later games by a single defeat.

## 10) Recognition and Awards

(a) The top 3 fighters are recognized in each group's individual weight category.

(b) The top three prizes (including the tiered-third-place) will be awarded with medals and honor certificates.

(c) In this tournament, there will be Dare Awards, and all the players who have not entered the top three will be recognized with the Dare Award and an issued certificate. Note: After the game, everyone should not leave the competition venue until the awarding ceremony is finished and a group photo is taken.

## 11) Notice to Fighters

(a) Fighters are subject to the arrangements of the organizing committee of the tournament, obey the rules of the tournament, and obey the judgment of the judge.

(b) The organizing committee will purchase special insurance for the competition for all participating fighters.

(c) Fighters must compete in accordance with the reasonable requirements of the competition rules during the competition. If any sports injury is caused by fouling actions on the playing field, and the individual, team (club) and the insurance company is responsible for all medical expenses. All other sports injuries are the responsible by fighters themselves, and the organizers are not responsible.

(d) The participation of foreign fighters only represents individuals or dojos and does not represent the country.

(e) Dressing requirements of participating fighters: White karate uniforms and the self-provided protective gears must be approved by the organizing committee

of the tournament. The staff of the inspection team of the organizing committee of the conference has the right to inspect the karate uniforms and the self-provided protective gears of any participating fighters. The participating fighters must actively cooperate with the inspection work. No hard objects (such as glasses, jewelry, pendants and pins, etc.) should be worn during the competition.

(f) If the team needs to hang banners, roll-ups, flags and other promotional materials on the venue, they must be suspended and arranged at the designated location after approval by the organizing committee. The organizing committee of the conference has the right to confiscate without permission.

## 12) Special Notice to Fighters

(a) Fighters shall strictly abide by the tournament procedures and must submit their personal information, such as age, weight, grade, height and photo, according to the fact. If the submitted information, including but not limited to the weight, is found to be inconsistent with the actual one, the organizing committee has the right to cancel the fighter's qualification of the tournament.

(b) Anyone who has been weighed for more than the registered weight shall be regarded as disqualification (Shigaku).

(c) Fighters must rest, observe and prepare for the competition in the designated area during the tournament. If there are special issues to leave, they must inform the team leader or the check-in personnel, and return to the team in time. Those who do not present in time will be regarded as a personal waiver by the organizing committee of the conference.

(d) During the competition of the fighter, only one accompanying coach or assistant shall be allowed to enter the fighting ground, and to give instructions within the designated area.

(e) During the competition of the fighters, the accompanying coaches or assistants shall not slap the stage on the sidelines or interfere with the normal order of the game with excessive behaviors. In such occasion, the referee has the right to warn them. Shall they continue to do so, the referee also has the right to give one-time warning to the related fighters during the competition or to order the accompanying coaches or assistants to exit the fighting ground.

(f) If the fighter disagrees with the judgment of the referee in the competition, the fighter shall report to the team leader, who could appeal to the organizing committee of the tournament (the organizing committee does not accept the appeal of the coach and the participating fighters directly). The organizing committee studies, discusses and then decide whether to maintain or change the

judgment. The organizing committee of the tournament has the final power of ruling and explanation.

(g) If any fighter disregards the arrangement of the organizing committee of the tournament or misbehave, the organizing committee of the conference has the right to cancel his/her qualifications of the competition.

### 13) Registration and Check-in

(a) Application deadline: April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019

(b) Materials required for the registration, such as the name, number, gender, age, group and weight category, shall be reported to the organizing committee by E-mail. A digital copy of all participating fighter's ID card/passport or a copy of the household registration book if Chinese minor shall be sent by E-mail to the organizing committee of the conference.

(c) The team leader and coach shall provide photos

### 14) Participation and Accommodation

(a) Accommodation and transportation expenses for each participating fighter shall be self-care.

(b) Entry fee (competition management fee): each fighter shall pay the competition management fee at 300 RMB for single group, or at 350 RMB if double groups per fighter (each includes a 50 RMB insurance premium already).

(c) Ticket fee: 100 RMB per ticket. And one can reserve at 80 RMB in advance. The reservation deadline is April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
